New Meridian library on schedule

City Council approves plans, construction to begin in May

MERIDIAN — Shhhhhh. Something special is happening in Meridian.

After breezing through the city's planning and zoning commission, officials from the Meridian Public Library received the nod from the City Council Tuesday to proceed with construction of the city's new 30,000square-foot public library.

OK'd the library, slated for 1323 W. Cherry Lane.

Library Executive Director Patty Younger said architects will work on building specifics, and construction bids will be out by early March.



Eagle officials more concerned about Boise River's higher waters

EAGLE - A solid year of snowfall in the mountainous regions and increasing temperatures have Eagle city officials concerned about the water level of the Boise River.

Mayor Chuck Bower, members of the Eagle City Council, and the Planning and Zoning Commission discussed the issue Tuesday in a joint workshop at City Hall.

City officials plan to draw up two ordinances in the coming months - a Boise River and stream system management ordinance, and a pathway ordinance.

Councilman Rick Yzaguirre, liaison to the pathway committee, said the group is still meeting but some members are "burnt out." He said members of the committee want to get the ordinance into place and not work on it "until hell

"It's been a good committee," said Yzaguirre of the five or six remaining members. "We don't want to keep dealing with individual developments,"

Yzaguirre and Bower agreed that new members need to be placed on the committee -- one that will dictate what is expected of developers who develop along the Boise

APA pitches Destination 2015 to board members Monday

About \$100 million tabbed for roads in Meridian

MERIDIAN — Transportation could be getting easier in Meridian and western Ada County in the years ahead.

Several major road projects — totalling about \$100 million — are planned for Meridian and the city's impact area during the next 20 years. The projects are outlined in the Ada Planning Association's Destination 2015 plan. The plan --which has been in the works for 2 1/2 years — is up for approval Monday by APA's board.

APA Deputy Director Erv Olen said the plan outlines roadway projects considered for Ada County.

In Meridian and the outlining impact area, five projects totalling \$12.75 million are on tap during the next six years. The projects include improving:

· Eagle Road from Fairview Avenue to Chinden Boulevard: \$8.5 million.

• Pine Street from Eagle Road to Cloverdale Road: \$350,000.

· Franklin Road from Linder Road to Meridian Road: \$2.5 million.

 Locust Grove Road from Ustick Road to Fairview Avenue: \$1.2 million.

 Ten Mile Road from Cherry Lane to Ustick Road: \$200,000.

projects within the next 20 years, and \$57.7 million tabbed for capitol projects for right-of-way preservation within the next 20 years.

Olen said Meridian's growth during the past 10 years makes transportation planning vital in the city of about 22,000 people.

"I think Meridian's growth rate has been explosive, to put it mildly, and we're trying to keep on pace with See DESTINATION on Page 2 Libraries in Meridian started with the Occident Club. They focused

library was opened at Songer Pharmacy. The Meridian Library's location was chosen in 1995

because it was the exact center of the city.

In 1950, the Occident Club purchased the Interurban Stage Station. By 1968, they had expanded the building to 1800 square feet.

The tree standing by the antique plow to the


north of the building is the only tree left from the original property.

There used to be two main libraries; Meridian Free Library District and the Meridian Public Library.


On August 16, 1975 the two combined to form the Meridian Library District.


The previous owner, Anna Koskela,
