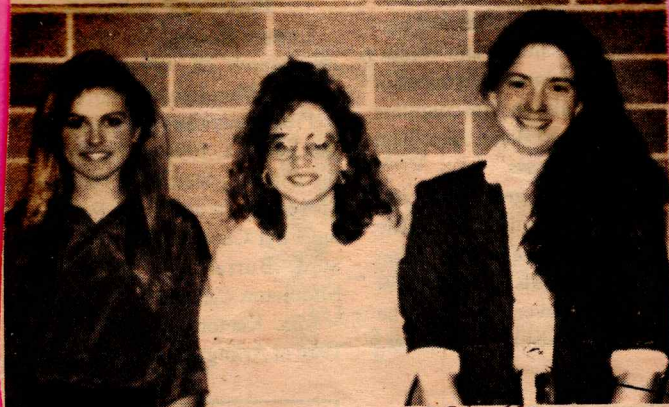
Friendship is a precious word

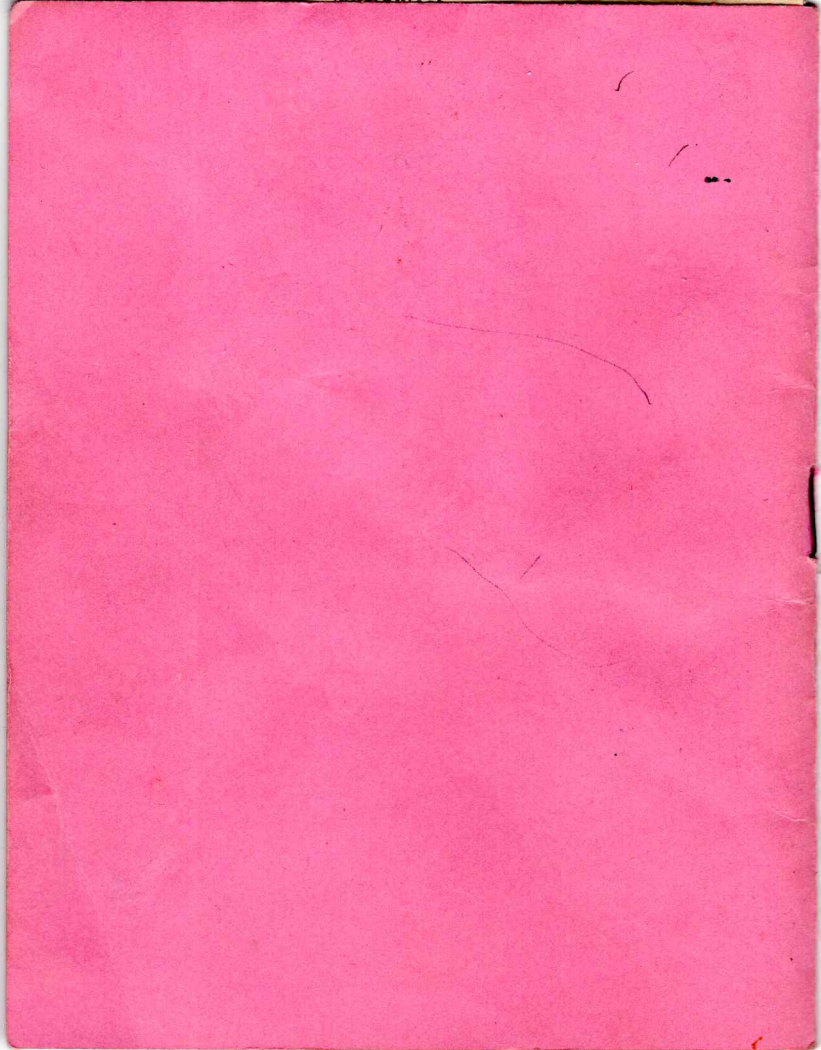
